Indian Mountaineering Foundation (IMF) is organizing the Sport Climbing Judges, Setters and Belayers Courses with the support of Atal Bihari Vajpayee Institute of Mountaineering & Allied Sports (ABVIMAS) at Manali (HP). Details are as follows:-

Judges Course

- Qualifications - Graduation
- Age Limit - Not less than 20 years
- Should have sound knowledge of the International Federation for Sport Climbing (IFSC) Rules system.
- Should have a good exposure in sport climbing.
- Should be physically/mentally and medically fit.
- Should be able to converse and communicate in English and Hindi.
- Course duration: 13 to 16 June, 2024 (Reporting 13 June, 2024 at 3 p.m. & Departure 17th June, 2024 (Morning))
- Each Zone to send two candidates (Preferably one male & one female)
- Course Fees : Rs.5,000/- (Inclusive of boarding and simple dormitory accommodation)

All participants for the judges course must download the 'Rules 2024–International Climbing Competitions' from the website www.ifsc-climbing.org and must study the same before partaking in the programme and also carry the Rule Book for the course. There will be a preliminary test (the performance of which will be reckoned for grading) on the first day of the course and the candidates should come prepared for the same. Details of the chapters to be studied will be intimated to you soon.



Climbing standards going up and many youngsters climbing higher grades, the emphasis in this training will be producing quality setters. It is mandatory to climb the prescribed grade to be able to attend the course for freshers, hence climbing test will be conducted before commencement of Course. Candidates who fail to comply with the standards will be sent back.

a)	Qualifications - 10th Class
b)	Age Limit - Not more than 30 years
c)	Should have minimum 7a+ (French grade) point climbing standards
d)	Should be physically/mentally and medically fit.
e)	Should be able to converse and communicate in English and Hindi.
f)	Course duration: 13 to 17 June, 2024 (Reporting 13 June, 2024 at 3 p.m. & Departure 18th June, 2024 (Morning)
g)	Each Zone to send two candidates(Preferably one male & one female)

Belayers Course



a)	Eligibility - Practical knowledge of Sport Climbing and above 18 years of age.
b)	Course duration: 13 to 16 June, 2024 (Reporting 13 June, 2024 at 3 p.m. & Departure 17th June, 2024 (Morning))
c)	Each Zone to send two candidates (Preferably one male & one female)

How to Reach Atal Bihari Vajpayee Mountaineering Institute and Allied Sports, Manali

The best way to reach Manali is to take an overnight bus from Delhi or Chandigarh. The broad gauge railway stations nearest to Manali are in Chandigarh (310 km) and Ambala (300 km). The nearest airport is in Bhuntar, which is also 50 km away. Buses and taxis are easily available from these places and other parts of North India to Manali.
