

IMF Approved Wilderness Advanced First Aid (WAFa)
Course 18th -21st March 2021

IMF has approved the WAFa course conducted by Hanifl Centre. Hanifl Centre conducts WFA, WAFa, WFR and CPR courses in India with the support and in collaboration with Aerie Backcountry Medicine, Montana, U.S.A. The course content for each course and Scope of Practice (SoP) for courses are regularly updated by Aerie under the umbrella of the Wilderness Medicine Society (that sets standards in the US). In addition, Aerie collaborates and consults with NOLS and other providers of wilderness medicine training in the US to stay abreast of the latest research in this field. The curriculum being taught is evidence based, and vetted on a regular basis. Aerie instructors (USA) and Aerie-India instructors are all outdoor professionals, and have been in this field for more than two decades. All participants get the Wilderness Medicine manual certifications accredited by Wilderness Medicine Society (WMS) and American Heart Association (AHA). IMF approved certification valid for 2 years will be issued for the course.
