Technical Meeting will be organized on Tuesday 20th December 2022 at 1400 Hrs. where only two Team Officials per team will be allowed.

Qualifying Age:

(i)	Sub Junior	10 to 13 Yrs (Born between 01.01.2009 to 31.12.2012)
(ii)	Junior	14 to 16 Yrs (Born between 01.01.2006 to 31.12. 2008)
(iii)	Senior	17 Yrs & above. (Born on 01.01.2005 & before)

Equipment/Climbing Gear:

Participants will bring their own climbing shoes and chalk bags which they would need for the competition. Technical equipment will be provided by the organisers.

Prizes:

Medal, Certificate will be awarded.

Migration:

Candidates willing to participate in Zonal/National Competition from a Zone different from the zone of domicile must obtain "NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE" from the present zone and submit current address proof to be eligible for participation in a competition.

How to get to Wellington, Nilgiris, Tamil Nadu.

By Plane:

Nearest airport is Coimbatore Airport.

Distance from Coimbatore airport to wellington is **70 km** by road . The Coimbatore is well connected to Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Pune , Mumbai, Chennai, Kolkota and Delhi.

By Train:

The nearest major rail station is **Coimbatore.** Although there are rail station in **Metupalyam.** The Nilgiri Passenger train a heritage train passes through Wellington, which also is a iconic railway station.

By Road:

Bus services from Coimbatore, Bengaluru and Chennai are well connected. Wellington is a town in the Nilgiris District of the Indian state of Tamil Nadu, 3 kilometers to the north of Coonoor on the NH181. The town includes a Wellington Bazaar, and the Wellington Cantonment. The Wellington Cantonment is home to The Madras Regimental Centre (MRC) and The Defence Services Staff College (DSSC).





ACCOMMODATION:

All qualified athletes and Officials will be provided accommodation at the at Wellington by IMF Services Zone.

The parents and guardians will have to stay under own arrangements.

Please note:

Training possibilities before the Nationals : In the week leading up to the **Nationals** due to the preparation the possible use of the facility will be severely limited.

A clear schedule showing when the facility can be used and when areas are closed or restricted will be shared with the zonal Chairman.





EVENT RESTRICTIONS (as of June 10, 2022)

The Addendum to IFSC Rules serves as the basis of all measures on site:

- Masks need to be worn indoors (isolation zone, call zone,..) except while climbing / exercising.
- All volunteers that are in contact with athletes and team officials will wear masks to protect them in the best way possible..
- Lead: ropes will be provided by the EO but will not be disinfected. In case you wish to bring your own rope, you can do so. Please note: the rope needs to be in good shape and needs to be checked by the Technical Delegate in the Call Zone, before it is used.

In case of symptoms of a respiratory illness, people need to stay away from the event, unless they tested negative for Covid-19 since the symptoms appeared.

No more measures such as testing regimes or vaccination certification will be needed to take part. If the local regulations should change, the new measures will be communicated as soon as possible.
