HOW TO GET TO BENGALURU BY AIR

Nearest Airport is the Kempegowda International Airport.

Bangalore is extremely well-connected by regular flights from Delhi, Mumbai and most other important cities in India and also has international carriers flowing in and out of the Bengaluru International Airport, which is located about 40 kilometers from the main city. A taxi from the airport would take about 45 minutes to reach the city.

BY TRAIN

Bangalore has two important railway stations - Bengaluru City Railway Station and Yeswantpur Junction. Both railway stations have regular trains running from Delhi, Mumbai, Pune and other major cities. For travelling within Bangalore, there is Namma Metro (with limited connectivity), which is an intra-city rail network set up by the Bangalore Metro Rail Corporation.



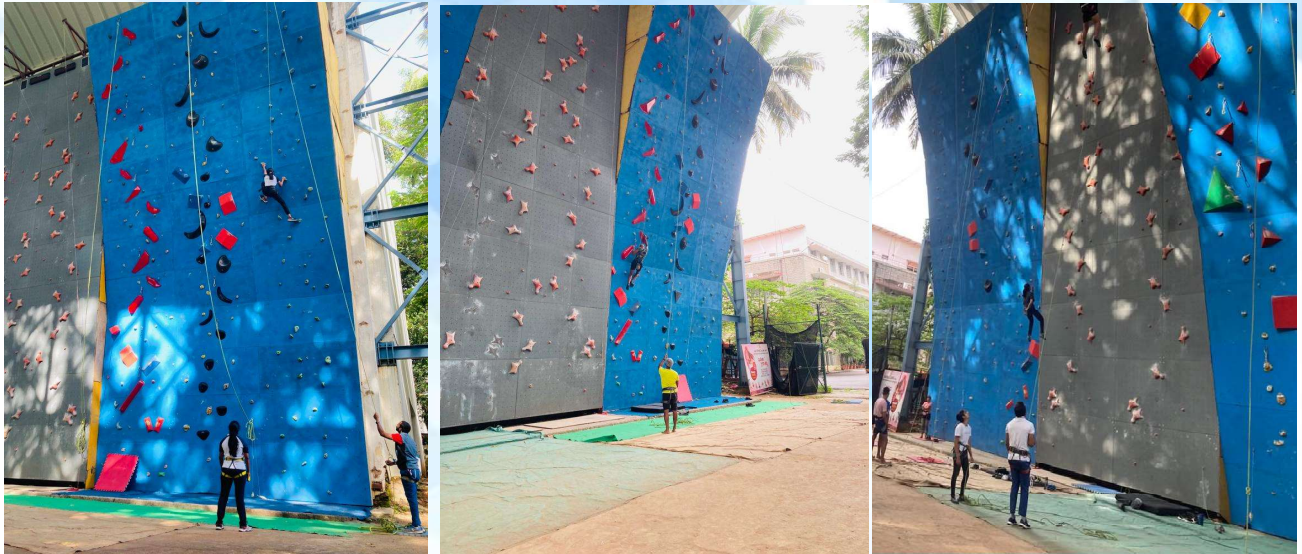
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ACCOMMODATION
